

“GENERAL SAFETY RULES”

(Updated: November 1, 2023)

FIREARMS PERMITTED:

Non-Restricted Firearms only.

Shotguns must be equipped with full length stocks and have a barrel length of a “MINIMUM 20 inches.”

AMMUNITION:

2 ¾” Target Loads Only.

Shot Size – #7 ½, #8 and #9.

Hunting loads are permitted at the Patterning Board.

- Eye protection is mandatory and hearing protection is advised for all shooters and spectators when outside of the club house and shelter/preparation area. Eye and hearing protection are mandatory when on a live fire shooting field.
- A “MAXIMUM” of two (2) shells may be loaded at one time unless on the Trap Field where only one is allowed (unless shooting “Doubles”).
- Shooting from the hip is not permitted. Shotguns “MUST” be fired from the shoulder.
- Shotguns may “NOT” be loaded until the shooter is on the shooting station and prepared to shoot.
- Shotguns “MUST” be carried unloaded and with the action opened.
